


**APOSTLES' CREED** - *Sundays after Pentecost, November 14<sup>th</sup>.*





Those communing may partake by providing their own bread and wine / grape juice at home. Our church can also supply you with prepackaged communion sets of a wafer and juice if you like. Gluten free is not available.*

### **Distribution**

*Holy Communion is about command and promise. Our Lord commands us to eat bread and drink wine in remembrance of him. Yes, we come to the altar out of obedience to Christ but we also come to the altar in joyous response to the promise of God given to you and to me through Jesus Christ for our forgiveness and our salvation.*

*Anyone who believes in the promise of Jesus Christ is invited to join the community of Christ at the Lord's Table. We believe that Jesus is indeed present in the bread and the wine. We believe that Jesus, God, is with us here and now.*
